Jerk Chicken

"This Jamaican barbeque marinade is a zesty blend of tangy, hot and sweet. Try Habanero peppers in place of jalapenos, if you're feeling spicy!"

Tonkatsu - Asian-style Pork Chop

"This is using Panko, which is Japanese bread crumbs (really light and airy, more so than crackers), and thinly sliced boneless pork chops."
