Teaching

- Student average ratings of instruction are 4.4 on a 5.0 scale
- Student ratings of instruction demonstrate that Dr. Doe is a demanding and challenging professor who is passionate about the subject matter and highly sought after as a professor
- Students particularly appreciate her availability outside of class to help them with questions
- Peer evaluations consistently rate Dr. Doe very highly, noting her ability to engage her students in intellectually stimulating discussions
- During the period under review, Dr. Doe taught 40 classes with six different preparations
- Her class sizes ranged from 20 to 80 with a median of 35 students

Scholarship/Creative Activity

- Dr. Doe has the second highest publication record in the department
- During the time under review, she published seven peer-reviewed articles—three of which appear in the top two journals in the field—and has two articles accepted and awaiting publication
- External reviews of Dr. Doe's scholarship indicate that her area of research has brought a "fresh perspective" to the discipline and is considered of high quality
- Most recently, Dr. Doe has begun to develop a research agenda that is more interdisciplinary, collaborating with faculty from the Jiann-Ping Hsu College of Public Health
- These collaborations have resulted in two conference presentations, both of which were well received

- Dr. Doe currently serves as President of the Southeast Region Pedagogy Association and has held leadership positions in other state and regional professional organizations

- Dr. Doe has served on numerous departmental and college committees always serving as an active contributor who is willing to take on assignments; especially noteworthy is her service on the departmental assessment committee where she led the effort to develop a new departmental assessment and evaluation plan
- Most notable is Dr. Doe's academic service in the local community where she has been an active presenter, educator, and problem-solver on issues relevant to her area of expertise
