- During the period under review, Dr. Public taught 35 classes with eight different preparations
- His class sizes ranged from 1 to 120 with a median of 40 students

- He has also published seven articles of which five are in peer-reviewed journals
- Dr. Public has published in *Science Standards* and *Science Education* which are rated 40th and 45th respectively in the discipline (out of a total of 160 worldwide ranked journals in the discipline)
