LEGISLATIVE EXEMPTION EXAM: This graduation requirement was initiated at the direction of the State Legislature to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia as one means of exposing graduates of state institutions to the fundamentals of the state/federal government and history. Students can obtain this “exposure” through academic course work or by demonstrating a proficiency on certain exams. The Registrar’s Office at Georgia Southern University determines if a student has satisfactorily met these graduation requirements. A student needing to meet these requirements by taking the Legislative Exemption Exam(s) needs to register for the exam(s) in the Testing Office in the Cone Hall Room 2031. The tests are given on an individual basis beginning your first semester at Georgia Southern University and may be taken twice in the semester you plan to graduate.
